

Krystal Newhouse



In March 2014, a vibrant and vivacious Walton High teen awoke in the middle of the night unable to breathe. She was rushed to the hospital where her family learned she had lymphoma. While undergoing treatment for lymphoma, Krystal suffered a seizure that, due to lack of oxygen, left her with brain damage. Self-employed and dealing with these unexpected events, Krystal's family needed help.

Upon learning of the needs of this family, the WCTC Fundraiser committee set about organizing a community-wide fundraiser to assist the Newhouses. The event raised awareness of the family's need and provided funds to assist them as they traveled back and forth between the hospital and home.

Later in the year, while the Newhouses were conducting business in our office, a team member learned the family was in need of a wheel-chair lift to help transport Krystal back and forth to doctor's appointments and therapy.



In November 2014, another fundraiser was launched to raise money for the wheel-chair lift. Both fundraisers, provided the family with \$7,616.16.
